Monday, June 10th:


• Yoga at 9:30 am. \$10 drop in. Bring your own mat, blanket, block and/or strap. Some will be available.

Classes begin on Thursday, June 13th. No class on July 4th. This class will be similar to the one on Tuesday mornings. For more details please refer to the class description above.




